SIGNS OF SENSORY PROCESSING DISORDER

- Shudders, gags, or vomits when attempting to try certain foods
- Avoids specific types of food (e.g. purees or chewy foods)
- Is fearful of trying new foods
- Insists on only eating certain brands of food
- Is unable to eat or does not eat well unless at home
- Limits self to food at a specific temperature
- Prefers bland foods and refuses most savory or intense flavors
- Craves intense foods
- Over-chews food
- Under-chews food and attempts to swallow large pieces
- Overstuffs mouth
- Requires liquids to swallow most bites of food
- Underreacts to hot and/or spicy foods
- Overreacts or underreacts to odors
- Consistently "slumps" at the table or is unable to stay in seat
- Has difficulty achieving gross or fine motor skill milestones, especially those related to eating
